Background

- Planned since mid-1980's
- Improves mobility and north-south connectivity
- Originally a six-lane Principal Arterial
- Now a four-lane Minor Arterial
- A-List project for current PPRTA Program




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What We've Heard

- Minimize the noise/visual impact
- Do not negatively impact the park, creek, or sensitive habitat areas
- Mesa Springs wants a pedestrian connection across Centennial Blvd
- Landscaping and natural buffers are preferred
- Keep cut-through and construction traffic out of Mesa Springs



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Project Overview by Segment

- Fillmore St to Mesa Valley Rd
 - Partially completed with VA Clinic
 - Maintain existing curbing
 - Construct missing segment
 - Adding sidewalk on west side
 - Curbed median with colored concrete
 - New top asphalt surface
 - Two access intersections (VA Clinic and future)



Project Overview by Segment

- Mesa Valley Rd to Van Buren St
 - Partially completed with Indian Hills development
 - Maintain existing curbing
 - Adding sidewalk on both sides
 - Curbed median with colored concrete
 - New top asphalt surface
 - Intersections at Mesa Valley Rd and Van Buren St




Project Overview by Segment

- Van Buren St to Mesa Creek/Madison St
 - New roadway construction
 - Painted median
 - No direct connection to Mesa Springs
 - Passes through former dump site and MVS development
 - Intersection at South end for future development
 - Variable topography



Project Overview by Segment

- Mesa Creek/Madison St to I-25/ Fontanero St
 - New roadway construction
 - Curves to avoid creek and property impacts
 - Corrects Fontanero St grade
 - Culdesacs at 7th St
 - Split level design
 - Wider sloping median
 - Traffic signals at I-25 ramps
 - Traffic signal at Chestnut St



Project Schedule

- Design continues through late 2016
- Construction planned to begin in 2017
- Construction completed by end of 2018
